
# Background








Statement 1: I support pursuing a renewable energy system for Matinicus.












# **Results: Ranking Question**



# **Results: Ranking Question**

- Ranking Question:
  - Most respondents indicated that cost was their primary concern
    - Not what was indicated on agree/disagree
  - Most popular response was to number answers from 1 – 3
  - Least popular response was to order answers from 3 – 1.
    - May indicate ordering bias

# Analysis: Agree/Disagree

- Very strong support for building a renewable energy project on Matinicus
  - 93% "Strongly Agree" / "Agree"
- Respondents were supportive of reducing environmental impact, minimizing costs, and ensuring local control over energy systems.
  - Ensuring local control:
  - Minimizing environmental impact:
  - Minimizing costs:

85% "Strongly Agree" / "Agree" 85% "Strongly Agree" / "Agree"

69% "Strongly Agree" / "Agree"



#### Analysis: Ranking

• Ranking question may not be accurate, evidence of "ordering bias", which may have influenced respondents to give a more favorable ranking to options higher on a list.
